Teacher of Character Awards

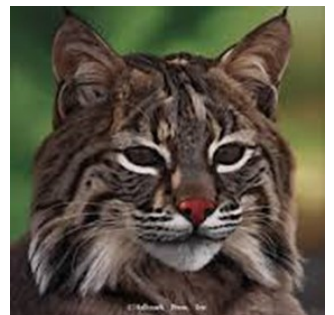
