Thanksgiving Luncheon

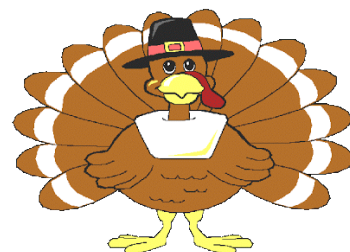
