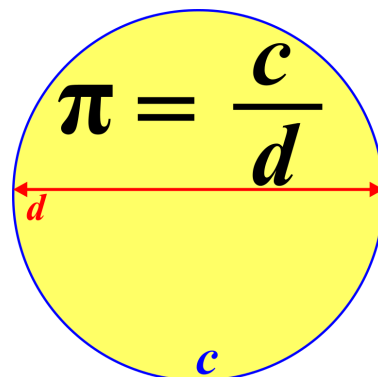
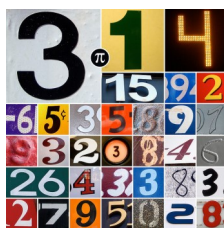
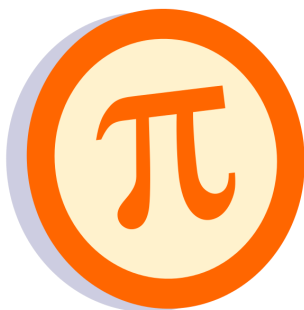
Hagerman Elementary PTO
